It has been a wonderful, challenging and eventful year for Cabonne/Blayney Family Day Care. We have seen many new changes in our service this year, from a new coordination unit, parenting groups, library sessions, e-signatures, harmony software, constant updates of information is shared to families from our service either by email or Facebook. Starting January 2018, new legislation states all children must have up to date immunisations in order to enroll in all child care services, unless there is a valid medical reason as to why they cannot be immunised. All new enrolments will need a current immunisation history statement before they commence care and all current enrolments will need to send updated immunisation history statements into the service when immunisations are received.

Grace was awarded Educator of the Month for her dedication towards all aspects of her work & for extra attention that is given to every child within her service.


DECEMBER 2017 Shirley Edwards



PIG THE ELF




In this rhyming story, the latest in a series from Australia, Pig the pug celebrates
