FROM THE COORDINATION UNIT

Wow, what an incredibly busy couple of months we have had! We apologise for not producing a newsletter since February, we are back on track now and will keep them coming every 2 months.

ASSESSMENT & RATING VISIT

On July 3 & 4, our Service was assessed and rated by the NSW Department of Education. Our Service will be rated against the 7 quality areas of the National Quality Standards and the National Regulations. They will give us an overall rating, form which we can receive a Working Towards, a Meeting or an Exceeding. During the assessment, the assessor spends time at the Service and with 3 randomly chosen Educators. We would like to send a MASSIVE thank you to our 3 wonderful Educator's who were chosen to be assessed; Kira Whiteman (Molong), Kirstyn Riley (Orange) and Leanne Gilmour (Orange). We believe we did very well & will receive our rating result in the coming weeks.

CHILD CARE SUBSIDY

The Coordination Unit would like to thank all parents for their patience and cooperation during the transition to the new Child Care Subsidy (CCS). We had a fairly smooth transition, with only a few hiccups so we are very fortunate. There are still some parents who need to complete their Eligibility Assessment. Please remember, once an enrolment is created, parents must log on to the MyGov account and confirm the enrolment before they are able to receive CCS.

2018-2019 FINANCIAL YEAR FEES AND CHARGES

As you are all aware, we raised our fees this new financial year. The fees and charges are now as following:

Re-Enrolment Fee (Occuring January of each year) - \$25 per family

New Family Enrolment Fee - \$50 per family

Administration Levy - \$1.30 per hour, per child

IMMUNISATION GRACE PERIOD

Our Service is required by new regulations to have up to date immunisation statements for all children. We are allowing a 2 month grace period from when an immunisation was due to hand a statement in before we suspend care. A letter or email will be sent when an immunisation is due to remind parents & another warning letter will be issued 1 month before the immunisation statement is due at the service.

We have 2 new Educators registered with our Service. Bonnie-Sue Mawbey started a Family Day Care Service in Yeoval on 2 July 2018 & Megan Gould will be starting early August in Parkes. 


BOOK CORNER

CRANBERRY & APRICOT MUESLI BARS



Ingredients

100g (1/2 cup) light canola or olive oil spread

2 tbs honey

1/3 cup unsweetened apple juice

1/2 cup dried cranberries

1/2 cup diced dried apricots

Canola or olive oil cooking spray

1 cup quick oats

1 cup sunflower and pepita seed mix

2/3 cup plain flour

2 tbs raw sugar

Method

- **1.** Combine spread, honey, apple juice, cranberries and apricots in a small saucepan. Place over a medium heat until spread is melted, stirring occasionally.
- **2.** Bring to the boil, then reduce heat to low and simmer uncovered for 5 minutes. Remove from heat, cool 15 minutes.
- **3.** Preheat oven to 180°C (160°C fan-forced). Grease an 18cm x 28cm slice pan with cooking spray and line with baking paper to cover base and extend up sides of pan.
- **4.** Combine oats, seed mix, flour and sugar in a large bowl, add dried fruit mixture and mix thoroughly.
- **5.** Press mixture firmly into prepared pan.
- **6.** Bake in preheated oven for about 25 minutes or until slice is light golden. Remove from oven and cool completely.
- **7.** Lift slice from pan using lining paper and cut into bars to serve
