

# CARAVAN PARK FEES FOR PENSIONERS POLICY

### Objective

Caravan park pensioner concessions will be made available to Seniors Card holders only once adequate proof of this classification is provided by the applicant.

### Introduction

Providing a reduced rate for aged pensioners and Seniors Card holders is considered a socially supportive measure and also a means of attracting customers to Council's caravan parks. This policy applies to all the caravan parks in the Cabonne LGA, Seniors Card holders and aged pensioners.

### Policy

Caravan park pensioner concessions will be made available to aged pensioners and Seniors Card holders - adequate proof of this classification must be provided by the applicant.

These reduced rates are detailed in the Fees and Charges each year.

### Responsibilities

**General Manager:** responsible for the overall control and implementation of the policy.

**Deputy General Managers & Leaders:** responsible for the control of the policy and procedures within their area of responsibility.

### Definitions

**LGA:** Local Government Area

**Seniors Card:** The NSW State Government introduced the Seniors Card scheme in 1992 to encourage older people to enjoy an active and healthy retirement. To qualify, you must be a New South Wales permanent resident, aged 60 or over and work no more than 20 hours a week.
