CTW advises its consumers that Level 5 water restrictions will come into effect from Sunday 5 April 2020.

| Residential – Irrigation of New Turf   | Not permitted   | Not permitted   |
| Washing down walls or paved surfaces   | Not permitted   | Not permitted   |
| Topping up private swimming pools/spas | Not permitted   | Not permitted   |
| First fill of private swimming pools   | Not permitted   | Not permitted   |
| Washing cars at home                   | Not permitted   | Not permitted   |
