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TERMS AND CONDITIONS | SEASON PASS

Upfront payments only, being made by cash or EFTPOS.

- Children under the age of 2 years are entitled to free entry.
- School children up to and including the age of 16 years are considered eligible to purchase a child season pass. Applicants under 18 years old must get a parent/guardian to sign the agreement and supervision requirements must be adhered to at all times.
- Passes must be produced upon entry. Daily rates will need to be paid for failure to produce a valid pass. If requested appropriate photo identification must be shown on entry to Cabonne Council swimming pools.
- Persons to be included on a Family Season pass, or Pensioner/Seniors Family season pass, must be patrons of the immediate family only (i.e. Parents and children) The only exception to this is Wards of the State under guardianship.
- To be entitled to purchase a pensioner season pass the applicant must be a holder of a Pension Card issued by the Department of Human Services or the Department of Veteran Affairs. This card must be produced for verification before issue of the ticket.
- Only parents that are holders of the Pension Card issued by the Department of Human Services or the Department of Veteran Affairs are eligible to apply for a Pensioner Family season pass.
- All users are required to comply with the Pools conditions of entry. A copy may be provided upon request and the conditions are displayed in the reception area of the swimming complex.
- Children under the age of 10 must be closely supervised by an adult (16 years and over). Entry is subject to Royal Life Saving Keep Watch Program supervision responsibilities. This policy can be provided upon request and signs displayed around the swimming facility.
- Refunds are considered and processed by management only when they have been submitted with an attached medical certificate or letter outlining the extenuating circumstances.
- A Village season pass gives you unlimited use of the 5 local village swimming pools (Cumnock, Cudal, Eugowra, Manildra & Yeoval) throughout the pool season as advertised on Councils website.
- Opening times and lane availability are subject to change at short notice and refunds will not be issued in this instance. This includes full closure for swimming events, health and safety requirements and inclement weather.
- Terms and conditions are subject to change at any time subject to Management discretion.

Safety Rules and Regulations

The following rules have been established for the benefit and protection of all users of the pool. These will help insure safe and sanitary operation of the facilities and provide enjoyable recreation for all patrons and their guests.

Parents should instruct their children to observe these rules and to obey the instructions of the Pool Administrator, Senior Lifeguard and the Lifeguards.

The following disciplinary procedures are in effect for failure to comply with the pool rules:

First offense....Warning

Second offense....One-Day Suspension

Third Offense....One Week Suspension

RULES FOR POOL ENCLOSURE (Area within pool fencing and including the parking lot)

Patrons MUST be paid in full before they may be admitted.

A SEASON PASS FAMILY INCLUDES:

- 1) Those living in the parent's home as a family
- 2) One or two responsible adults caring for the children.

Child-minders' are included with prior notification only.

Child-minders' MUST be in the duties of caring for children. If the child-minder is accompanying the adults in the family the person must pay admission.

A SEASON PASS FAMILY does not include:

- 1) Children who have established their own separate home
- 2) Children that a season pass holder is caring for

ALL Children under 12 MUST be accompanied by an adult or have passed a swim competency test.

Alcoholic beverages are not permitted during normal operating hours. Anyone showing signs of intoxication will be asked to leave the facility. Lifeguards and Administrators will respectfully ask you to remove the alcohol from the premises.

Swimming aids and toys in the pool are allowed at the discretion of the administrators and lifeguards.

GLASS OBJECTS and FORBIDDEN in the pool area.

No chewing of gum inside the fenced area will be tolerated.

No open refreshments are allowed in the pool water. No Exceptions!

All debris will be put in the rubbish containers provided.

Pool chairs, if available, are for sitting only. Please do not tip, rock or abuse the pool furniture.

Wilful damage to property by patrons or their guests will be charged to the patron involved.

Animals are not allowed on the pool premises.

No smoking is permitted within the pool enclosure. See designated areas for smoking outside the pool gates.

No profanity or abusive language tolerated on Cabonne Council Property.

No inappropriate or offensive behaviour tolerated on Cabonne Council Property.

No spouting of water, spitting or similar unhygienic activities will be tolerated.

No running, wrestling or horseplay on the concrete and around the pool.

No mermaid tail suits allowed.

No diving from the side of the pool except in the designated diver area with supervision.

No jumping or diving into the pool too near others.

No diving or jumping off ladders.

No flips and twists allowed.

No Swimming unless at least one lifeguard is on duty.

Stay way from the lifeguard stand. Do not distract the lifeguards from their work.

WADING POOL / TODDLER POOL / SPLASH POOL

A RESPONSIBLE ADULT MUST ATTEND ALL CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES WITHIN ARMS LENGTH.

Children over (6) years of age are not allowed in the wading/toddler pool.

SWIM NAPPIES ONLY!!!DISPOSABLE DIAPER ARE NOT ALLOWED. Cloth nappies with rubber pants are acceptable.

No Running in the wading / Toddler / Splash pool area.

Small non-rigid, unbreakable toys are permitted in the pool.

Please assist us in enforcing these policies.
