

# Cabonne Council Register of Government Contracts July 1 2023 to June 30 2024

The GIPA Act commenced on 1 July 2010. Cabonne Council will, when it engages in any contracts to the value of more than \$150,000 with private sector bodies, publish these in the following Register of Government Contracts. Contracts will be included in the Register for at least 30 days or until the Contract expires.

**Class 1 Contracts** - contracts that have, or are likely to have, a value of \$150,000.

**Class 2 Contracts** - Class 2 contracts are Class 1 contracts where:

- there was no competitive tender or quoting process and terms were negotiated directly with contractor, e.g. a standard form contract was not used, or it was used but significant changes were negotiated to it; or
- contracts where there was a competitive tendering or quoting process but the signed contract (whether or not a standard one) is substantially different from the draft issued to obtain quotes; or
- contracts contain obligations for maintenance or operations for 10 years or more; or
- contracts involve a privately financed project; or
- contracts involve transfer of a significant asset of the agency to another party in exchange for the transfer of an asset to the agency.

**Class 3 Contracts** - If a class 2 contract has a value, or likely value of more than \$5 million, it becomes a class 3 contract. Council will also publish a copy of class 3 contracts on its website.

**Confidential information that is not required to be included in register are:**

- the commercial-in-confidence provisions of a contract, or
- details of any unsuccessful tender, or
- any matter that could reasonably be expected to affect public safety or security, or
- a copy of a contract, a provision of a contract or any other information in relation to a contract that is of such a nature that its inclusion in a record would result in there being an overriding public interest against disclosure of the record.
