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INFORMATION FOR TENDERERS

GENERAL

1 PROJECT IDENTIFICATION AND DESCRIPTION

This tender is for Contract No.1799187 Construction of the DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE CABONNE SHIRE COUNCIL TOWN POOLS UPGRADES – STAGE 2. The contract will be a Lump Sum utilising the NSW Government MW21 form of contract.

Cabonne Council maintains seven aquatic facilities across the LGA. The pools are highly valued by the local community they serve. All seven aquatic facilities were originally built over 50 years ago and provide almost identical services due to their similar design, scale and quality.

Unfortunately, due to their age, the plant rooms and water treatment systems require replacement and have noncompliance issues.

Cabonne's Pools are of an older configuration with the filtration rates below recommended. Upgrades to plant room filtration systems can be easily facilitated through system upgrades that utilise common plant, filters, Cl generators, Cl analysers, pumps and products that are off the shelf.

Whilst the proposed scope of works is detailed within this document, the Pool Water Treatment Contractor is responsible for the final detailed design and coordination for the installation and commissioning.

Cabonne Council has secured Funding to upgrade the facilities identified in the list below including filtration, plumbing and reticulation systems, energy efficiency improvements and risk mitigation.

Following submission from tenderers and assessment of the submissions, Cabonne Council may elect to undertake the whole of the works or part of the works to fit within the current budget.

List of Stage 2 sites and current equipment:-

- Manildra Pool – 25m pool + toddler pool – Spherical Sand Filters, Prominent Control System, Prominent Beta Dosing Pumps – Acid & Cl, NaOCI – 3000L Bulk Storage.
- Cudal Pool – 25m pool + toddler pool – Spherical Sand Filters, Prominent Control System, Prominent Beta Dosing Pumps – HCl Acid & Cl, NaOCI – 3000L Bulk Storage.
- Eugowra Pool – 25m pool + toddler pool – Spherical Sand Filters, Prominent Control System, Prominent Beta Dosing Pumps – Acid & Cl, NaOCI – 3000L Bulk Storage.

Scope

Undertake the works as detailed within this document comprising the Final Design, supply, installation, commissioning, testing, training, handover and 12-month defects period of the pool water treatment plant upgrades.
