Council Meeting Snapshot

Cabonne Council held its April Council meeting on Tuesday, 22 April 2025. Key decisions included:

- Council has agreed to engage NSW Public Works to undertake concept design and planning for the **Molong CBD Stormwater and levee upgrades** as outlined in the draft Molong Flood Risk Management Study and Plan.
- **Council is providing funding support to:**
 - Molong St Johns Ambulance
 - Canowindra New Vogue and Social Dancing Group 12- hour dance event and Cumnock Family Fun Day
 - Cudal Central, Manildra and District Improvement Association,
 - Cumnock and District Progress Association, Yeoval Historical Society, Yeoval Preschool, and Nashdale Lidster Public Hall.
- **Council has also agreed to award tenders for:**
 - The Molong Hockey Field Relocation
 - The survey, investigation, design and associated work for Lake Canobolas and Gumble Roads.



Future Plans on Display

Council's Integrated Planning and Reporting (IP&R) framework helps guide the delivery of future services and infrastructure for our community. It brings together key documents—including the **Delivery Program, Operational Plan, and Resourcing Strategy (which includes the Long-Term Financial Plan, Asset Management Plan, and Workforce Management Plan).**

The draft IP&R documents will be on public display on Council's website and at the Cabonne Council Chambers from **Wednesday 23 April to Wednesday 21 May 2025.**

Roads Update

Obley Road – Pavement rehabilitation is underway along a 2.4 km section of road. Gravel overlay has been spread and compacted in preparation for stabilisation works.

Banjo Paterson Way – A 900-metre section near Bicton Lane has now been sealed.

Bluebell Estate – Sub-base material has been placed and compacted. Streetlights and NBN services have been installed, with kerb installation scheduled as the next stage.

Warraderry Way – Council crews have completed and sealed several heavy patches under the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA).

Nangar Road – A 2.5 km section near Trajere Road has now been sealed with bitumen.

Casuarina Drive – Repair work is underway across 6,600m² of pavement at various locations along the road.

State Roads:

Packham Drive – Heavy patching, drainage, and vegetation removal have been completed between Molong and Manildra. Transport for NSW has also approved rehabilitation and widening of a 250m section near a recent crash site, with works scheduled to begin later this month.

Resealing Works – Approved segments of the state road network have been resealed. Linemarking is underway, with remaining sections to be completed during the crew's next visit.
