Following the devastating flooding that was experienced at Canowindra in November 2022, Cabonne Council has secured funding from the NSW Government to undertake a review and update of the existing flood risk management study and plan for the township.

An important first step in the process is to gather information on recent flood events and to appraise what flood related issues are important to the community.

Molong Town Centre Activation Plan

Stage 2, phase 1 of the Molong Town Centre Activation Plan has commenced and is due to be completed week commencing 25 March 2024 (prior to Easter). This stage encompasses the bottom end of Bank Street, between Local Land Services and Molong Hardware Store.

The work zone has been planned to ensure traffic can still flow and pedestrians still have access to businesses and homes throughout the project.

Council encourages the community and visitors to continue to support the local businesses during the activation works.

Parking is available along Bank Street (outside of the construction zone), Gidley Street, along the Mitchell Highway/Watson Street and at the Railway Station.

Washpen Bridge Replacement

Council crews have commenced the reconstruction of Washpen Creek Bridge and associated road improvement works on Gundong Road, Obley for approximately 6 months.

The works include the reconstruction of the bridge, realignment of the approaching road pavement and associated drainage works. Disruptions to traffic flow are being kept to a minimum.

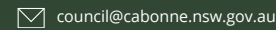
