Council Update

Work is well underway on the lining of the **Eugowra Pool**, which was significantly damaged during the 2022 flood event. This process is expected to continue over the next couple of weeks and may produce a noticeable odour in the surrounding area. Upgrades to the pool amenities, kiosk and plant rooms are also progressing well.

The refurbishment of the **Cabonne Home Support (CHS)** building in Canowindra continues on schedule, with works moving steadily toward early 2026 completion.

The Canowindra Town Centre & River Precinct Activation Project was officially opened on Friday, 20 June 2025. The project delivered a new suspension-style Swinging Bridge, widened footpaths, upgraded gardens, heritage-style furniture, and improved access throughout the precinct.

Demolition of the **flood-damaged tennis building in Molong** will be finalised in the coming weeks, making way for future improvements to the site.

Council has released the tender for the construction of the **new multi-purpose courts at Manildra**, a key community sport and recreation project for the town.

We're also proud to announce that **Cabonne Council has** received an **LG Award** for our Unsupervised Pools Initiative — a fantastic recognition of our commitment to community safety and innovative local government practices.

Roads Update

Packham Drive – The recently stabilised section near the solar farm has now been sealed. Works near Pecks Road are continuing, although recent wet weather has caused some delays. Sealing of this section is anticipated by the first week of July.

Casuarina Drive - Current patching works have now been sealed with linemarking to be done as soon as the contractor is available.

Bluebell Estate, Canowindra - All kerb & gutter has now been completed the with contractor preparing the pavement for sealing. General site clean-up to take place before the end of June.

Gravel Roads – Maintenance grading is scheduled to commence shortly in response to recent wet weather and increased surface wear.

Bitumen Roads – The recent rain has impacted several sections of the sealed road network. Council crews are attending to pothole patching as conditions allow.

Paytens Bridge, Eugowra -Motorists are advised of ongoing changed traffic conditions at Paytens Bridge, 11km south-west of Eugowra.

Motorists should allow:

- +30 minutes for detours (vehicles over 23 tonnes)
- +10 minutes for local access (vehicles under 23 tonnes)
