Flood Damage Repairs to Road Network Commencing Soon

Flood damage repairs to Cabonne's road network are scheduled to commence in late September/early October under the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA) program.

Where:

- Banjo Paterson Way: between Yeoval and Cumnock
- Banjo Paterson Way: between Cumnock and Molong
- Renshaw McGirr Way: Parkes side of Yeoval
- Eurimbla Road
- Obley Road: between Yeoval and the Dubbo Council boundary
- Gundong Road

It is anticipated that, subject to favourable weather conditions, this work will be completed prior to Christmas. Drivers are encouraged to exercise caution around work zones.

Improvements Across Cabonne

Cabonne Council is pleased to update you on several key projects that are making great strides across our region.

From infrastructure upgrades to enhancing community facilities, here's what's happening:

Swinging Bridge Canowindra

• The old bridge has been removed, and work has begun on rehabilitating the riverbank. The new bridge is expected to be completed by the end of November, providing a much-needed update to this iconic structure.

Montana Park, Manildra

• Construction started on 16 September for a new footpath and basketball halfcourt. Once the concrete work is completed, new amenities will be added, with the entire project due for completion by late November.

Eugowra Multi-purpose/Evacuation Centre

• Due for completion in December.

Town Entrance Signage

• Fresh new entrance signs for Cabonne's towns are currently in production and will be installed by the end of November, adding a welcoming touch for residents and visitors alike.

Cargo Tennis Courts

• Work at the Cargo Tennis Courts is awaiting a Geotech report to address drainage concerns. Once this is resolved, the project will move forward to further enhance the facility.

Yeoval Sports Precinct Upgrades

• Council will soon meet with key stakeholders to determine how the remaining funds should be spent to best benefit the community.

Pool Plantroom Upgrades

• The plant room upgrades for Yeoval, Cumnock, Molong, and Canowindra pools will be completed by mid-October. These improvements will enhance water quality, circulation rates, and reduce operational costs, ensuring a better experience for pool users.

Unsupervised Pools

• Starting this season, Cabonne's pools will be accessible daily from 6 am to 7 pm, allowing for more flexible, extended use for the community.
