Recent Works and Community Improvements

2024 was a year of progress for Cabonne Council, and 2025 is set to be even more exciting with several key projects now completed and new initiatives underway.

The Eugowra Multipurpose Centre is now open, offering a space for community events and activities.

In Canowindra, the new Swinging Bridge and walkway enhance the town's charm and provide a safer crossing of the river.

The upgraded Tennis Courts in Cargo and improvements at Montana Park in Manildra also provide new recreational spaces for the community.

Roads Update

Heavy patching is complete on Canowindra Road and Wellington Street, Molong. Pavement rehab on Banjo Paterson Way near Bicton Lane is expected to finish by mid-February, with resealing ongoing on several roads.

Crews are clearing storm debris and maintaining gravel roads in Mullion Creek. NDRRA-funded repairs are underway on Warraderry and Nangar Roads.

Work on the Bluebell Estate extension is progressing, with sewer, electrical, and NBN conduit installations complete. Stormwater pipes will be done by the end of January, allowing for road pavement and kerb preparation.
